Slovak Republic

- Location: Central Europe (17° - 22° E, 47° - 49° N)
- Area: 49 035 km²
- The prestigious global travel guides publisher Lonely Planet ranked Slovakia among the top 10 destinations of 2013
- Most events will take place in **Bratislava – the Capital on the Danube River**
- Excellent location – just 60 km to Vienna, 200 km to Budapest and 330 km to Prague
