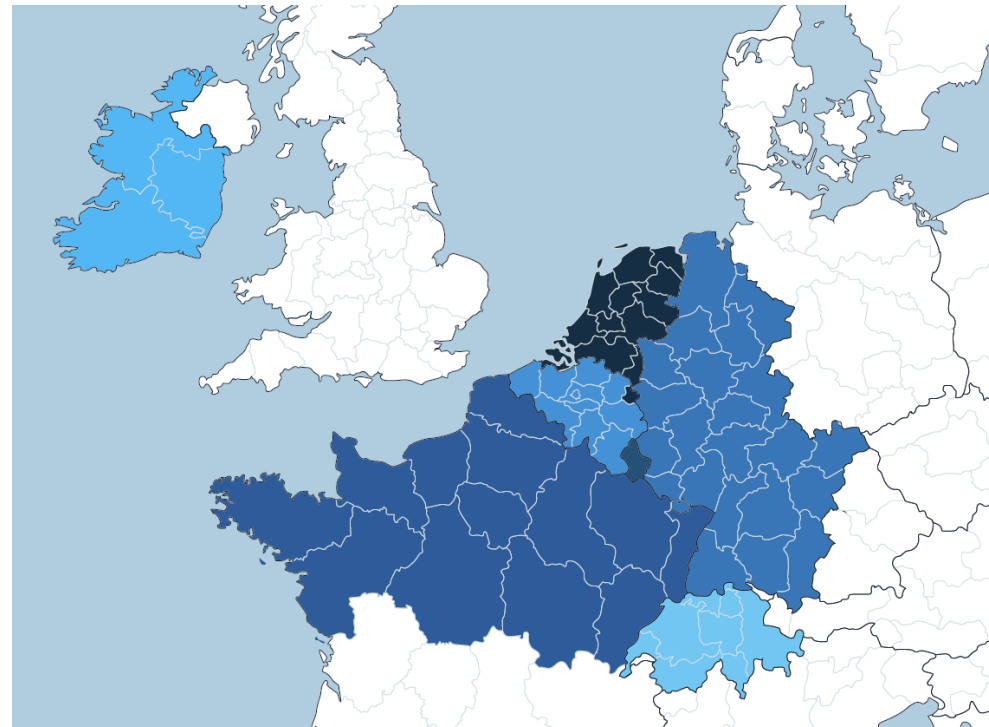

 - At least **2 partners from the NWE area**
 - **Organisations outside the NWE area** can join, if well justified
 - **Roles:** Lead partner, Project partner, Associated organisations

What makes a good project? (1)

A transnational need and relevance

- transnational problem or need
 - need for cooperation between organisations

What makes a good project? (2)

A clear contribution to Interreg NWE Programme's objectives

- contribution to one of the Programme's Specific Objectives
 - realistic and achievable project's objective
 - realistic, well defined and quantified outputs and results

What makes a good project? (3)

Going beyond existing approaches

- Do not reinvent the wheel!
 - Explain how your project builds on previous work / projects / experiences
-

What makes a good project? (4)

Strong partnership and cooperation to reach your project's objective

- Explain added value of transnational cooperation
 - Justify the types of organisations involved and why they are needed

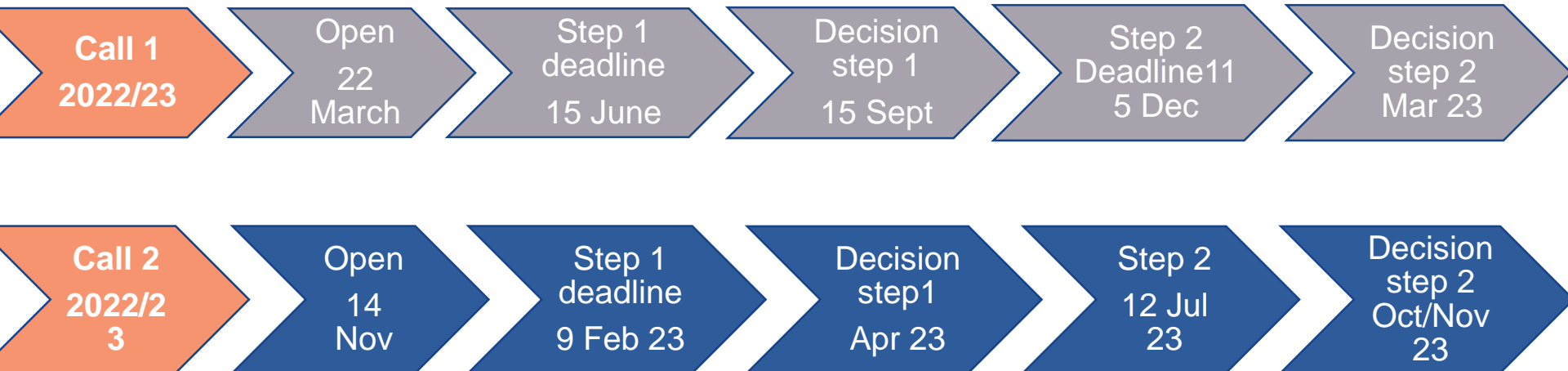

- 2 step process of approx. 1 year duration

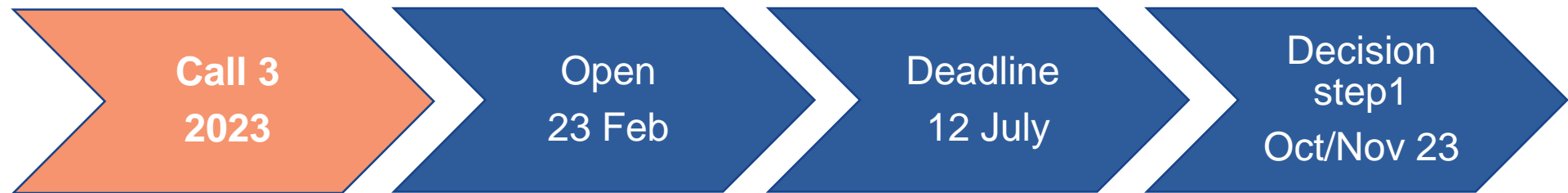


The NWE Programme
