



- Provide a practical forum for the transfer of competence to the countries in transition to democratic market economies
- Improve the level of information in BSR countries on current trends and problems in other countries in the region
- Assess important infrastructure projects to receive international financial contributions
- Promote spatial planning in the participating countries and regions

Resolution

A General

 The Ministers welcome the report "Vision and Strategies around the Baltic Sea 2010" (VASAB 2010) as a spatial development perspective for the Baltic Sea Region (BSR) and a useful basis for further strengthening and harmonization of national and regional spatial planning policies.

- 2. The VASAB 2010 initiative acquires special importance since it combines into a harmonicus whole the experience and development efforts of the West, Central and East European countries, constituting one area of communication between countries members of the European Union and countries waiting for admission or expecting close relations with it.
- 3. VASAB 2010 is an essential element of a wider process of harmonization of spatial development on a European scale, being a programme compatible with the efforts of the European Union, Central European Initiative and the Burents Sea Council in this respect. The member states of the European Union are upon to take VASAB into due consideration when preparing its European Spatial.

B Approval

- The Ministers stress the need for democratic spatial planning to promote sustainable development. Spatial planning shall contribute to spatial cohesion and rely on the principles of subsidiarity, participation and transparency.
- 5. The proposed visions and goals for this future special structure of the BSRs are an important frame of reference for the long-time special development of the region. The visions for the utrain system, the notality network, the specific types of areas and the lightning system point out a direction that can promote space of areas and the after an exposure of the specific special national and international level.

- Joint visions and strategies are
 not a comprehensive "mega plan" for the
 region. But they are to be taken into account by
 the authorities when drawing up their own
 spatial policies
- Strategies and actions concentrate on aspects of cross-national or Baltic interest
- Concertation on a broad scale was sought with other organizations and international initiatives
- Based on prognoses for 2010 and taking into account trends / challenges






Implementation





Long Term Perspective


- LTP concentrates on policy themes, where transnational cooperation in spatial planning provides a clear added value:

 (1) urban networking and urban-rural relations, (2)
 accessibility, and (3) sea space planning and management
- LTP particularly addresses territorial disparities in the field of socio-economic development (east-west, north-south, urbanrural divides)
- LTP is complementary to transnational actions of other organisations (no duplication of efforts)
- LTP a combination of policy and 22 actions (involving stakeholders)







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
Accessibility potential by air Change 2001 - 2011 (%)
