Cross Border Review

- Aim: combine successful Interreg programmes with additional strategic actions to tackle persistent border obstacles
- Actions:
 - **21/09 – 21/12 3 months on-line public consultation**
launched by Commissioner Crețu in Vienna-Bratislava on 21/09
echoed by REGIO senior management on other EU borders 23/09 to 09/10
 - **21 months study** on obstacles at EU internal land borders (started July 2015)
 - Series of **workshops/events** with key stakeholders (started Sept 2015)
 - **Issue paper** expected end 2016, with actions due before the end of Commission mandate
